Quake Safe Your Home



Wellington was said to be the Quake Capital of New Zealand. No one ever thought an earthquake would shake Christchurch to its core. What if it happened in Auckland? What steps can you take to reduce damage to your home?

Secure ornaments. Even small shakes can cause damage. Use non-slip mats, blu-tak or plastic putty to secure them.

Use close hooks to secure mirrors, pictures, photos, paintings and strong cord instead of string. Secure tall furniture to wall studs with brackets.

Use a metal strap available from a hardware store to secure your hot water cylinder. Small shakes can cause crack pipes. During bigger shakes, hot water can be a hazard or tip over and deprive you of valuable drinking water.

Non slips mats or velcro pads work are ideal for small appliances.

Use positive catching child-proof latches on cupboards and drawers. Magnetic ones won't hold during a quake

Store heavy objects in lower shelves or locked closed cabinets.

Have flexible gas and plumbing fittings installed by a tradesperson

Check your house is bolted to it's foundations

Secure your chimney with galvanised metals bands.

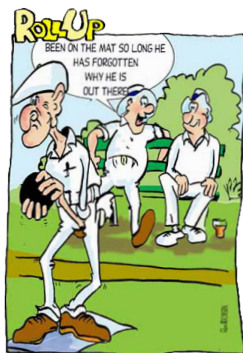
• The Pink Floyd Experience Pulse Tour 2011
